#### PROJECT.




#### DATES.

### KEY POINTS FROM RESEARCH.

35% of American children arrive at kindergarten without the basic language skills they will need to learn to read. Literacy skills include recognizing letters of the alphabet, understanding that books are read left to right, and being able to tell and understand stories. 88% of first graders who are below grade level in reading will continue to read below grade level in fourth grade. Reading difficulties can contribute to school failure, when increases the risk of absenteeism, dropping out, juvenile delinquency, substance abuse, and teen pregnancy.
